

WHAT TO KNOW ABOUT

DEEPNUDES

AND OTHER AI-GENERATED SEXUAL CONTENT



Deepfake nudes – also called **“DEEPNUDES”** – are fake photos, videos, or audio clips made using AI that make it look and sound like a real person is **naked or in a sexual situation, when they never were.**



You might think it's no big deal to make a deepnude because it's not actually a real nude of someone.

Maybe you're curious what someone might look like without clothes, think it's a joke, or want to try out these new AI tools.

None of these reasons give you permission to use another person's body or identity this way.

IT IS NOT OKAY TO MAKE DEEPNUDES BECAUSE:



They violate people's right to control their own body, image, and sexual expression.



They can cause serious emotional, social, and reputational harm.

CREATING DEEPNUDES CAN HAVE LEGAL CONSEQUENCES:



Using AI to create sexual images or videos of anyone under 18 is illegal in Canada and can lead to criminal charges, even if the person depicted isn't real.



Recent changes to Canadian law also make it illegal to share or distribute deepnudes of adults without their consent.
